SUBJECT - MATTER AND PURPOSES

The Lisbon International Intellectual Property Summer Course is jointly promoted by the Law School of the University of Lisbon (Faculdade de Direito da Universidade de Lisboa) and the Portuguese Society for Intellectual Property Law (Associação Portuguesa de Direito Intelectual).

Its aims are to provide participants with a broad and up to date overview of the main issues concerning the legal regulation of copyright and neighbouring rights, industrial property rights and their enforcement in a cross-border environment.

Particular emphasis will be given to the challenges faced by IP in light of recent technological developments.

The course will also allow participants the opportunity to network with each other and to enjoy the cosmopolitan atmosphere of Portugal's friendly capital. Lectures will be given in English by reputed specialists from several countries in Europe and America.

The course is aimed at law students, legal practitioners and academics interested in IP Law and related matters. No prior knowledge of the subject matter of the course is required, but a reasonable command of the English language is necessary for all participants.

LECTURING SCHEDULE AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

The course will be held from Monday to Friday, 9:30 till 11:00; 11:30 till 13:00 (20 sessions). Afternoon time will be free. A welcome reception and a farewell dinner will be offered respectively on 1 and 12 July 2019. An optional tour to Coimbra, on Saturday 6 July, will be arranged, including a visit to the University, a lunch and a workshop lectured by its Law Faculty comprising two sessions, at 10:30 and 14:30 respectively.

ACCOMODATION AND MEALS

Accommodation can be provided at preferential rates, at Hotel NH Campo Grande, at a 5 minutes walking distance from the Lisbon Law School, or at a nearby University residence. Costs of accommodation shall be borne by participants. The Law School has three cafeterias that provide lunches at reasonable cost. A choice of nearby restaurants is also available.

TUITION

Tuition fee is € 2.500. The tuition fee includes course attendance and materials, the welcome reception and the farewell dinner. The Coimbra optional tour, lunch and workshop have an additional cost of €150, subject to a minimum of 10 participants.

REGISTRATION, NUMERUS CLAUSUS AND CERTIFICATION

Registration will be available as of 2 November 2018. An early bird discount of 10% is awarded to registrations made until 17 December 2018. The course *numerus clausus* will be of 40 participants. Registrations will be treated on a first come, first served basis. A certificate of attendance in English will be issued jointly by the Lisbon Law School and the Portuguese Society for Intellectual Property Law. Attendance of the Coimbra Workshop will be specifically mentioned in the certificate.
